Climate change considerations will influence some of the next investments in infrastructure -- traditional, residential, green energy, and otherwise.

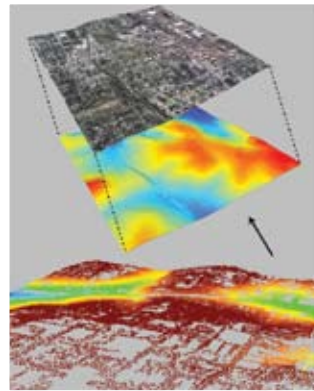
